If your child has not had a recent physical examination, or if there is any doubt about physical capabilities or abilities, we urge you to have an examination to ensure your child is physically able to participate.

In the event of an injury or sickness occurs in the course of California Prospects Baseball activities, I hereby authorize officials of California Prospect Baseball to administer first aid and if necessary to transport my child to a duly licensed physician or hospital. CODE OF CONDUCT

For Players Coaches Parents/Spectators

This policy letter from the California Prospect Baseball (CPB) coaches states the requirements for conduct by ALL people involved with California Prospects as well. It is the responsibility of all managers, coaches, umpires, league officials, parents, fans and players to understand what is expected of them. Issues related to code of conduct should be directed to the Division Director.

Our guiding principles are the following: Official Regulations and Playing Rules, and policies of the Prospects Baseball Organization, specifically, regulation – Also, all local rules and policies as defined by the California Prospects Board of Directors and our mission statement.

Players

- Treat opponents with respect; shake hands after each game
- Respect the umpires and abide by the rules of the game.
- Accept seriously the responsibility of representing your team and the league by displaying positive behavior at all times.
- Always show good sportsmanship during and after the game.

Managers/Coaches

- Set the example for the players, parents and fans to follow.
- Respect the umpires at all times
- Treat opposing players, managers, coaches, parents and fans with respect
- Continually instruct players in sportsmanship and demand it at all times.

Parents/Spectators

- All spectators should encourage players and never criticize players, managers, coaches or umpires.
- All spectators should stay back from the dugout and not interact with players at any time during warm-ups or the game.
- Spectators should assist in keeping non-players back from the playing area
- Any time a parent or spectator has issue with coaching, umpire calls or players, comments should be directed to the division head or player agent after the game and away from others.
